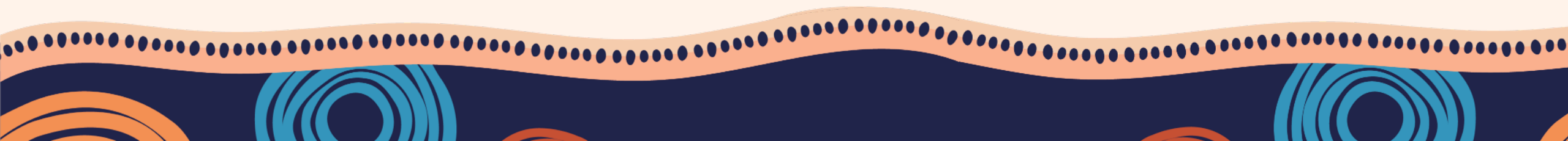

The Forum represents FVPLSs across the country. This **evidence base** means the Forum is uniquely placed to identify and address relevant policy, legal and funding reforms.



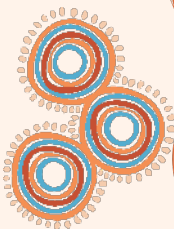
